PAVILION

REEF HOUSE

Just steps from the sand, Reef House looks out to intoxicating views of Little Dix Bay. Drawing on the rich heritage of the region, Reef House utilizes the freshest local provisions from land and sea, herbs from the resort's own garden and simple preparation methods to deliver a contemporary take on the bold flavors of the Caribbean. The farm-to-table menu includes exceptional vegetarian options and signature dishes.

RUM ROOM

Set next to the Pavilion, the eclectic, Wallaby-shingled Rum Room is dedicated to the liquid gold of empires, adventurers and buccaneers. Throughout the day and into the evening, bartenders mix cocktails from the resort's formative years—classics from the 1960s and 1970s, such as martinis, fizzes, highballs and the Collins. Overlooking the glistening bay, the bar spills out onto a terrace for those who prefer to combine their drinks and conversation with a dose of sun and surf.

COOKING CLASSES AT PAVILION



RESTAURANT & BARS

SUGAR CANE RESTAURANT

Sugarcane Restaurant offers upscale dining and a bar with poolside drinks, lounging and sunbeds. Featuring a large pool looking across the channel toward Tortola and a surrounding terrace with sun loungers, umbrellas and poolside tables, the restaurant features all day dining with an extensive wine and cocktail list as well as a bar menu with a selection of beer and snacks.

ACTIVITIES

THE BATHS

The centre piece of this dramatic area on Virgin Gorda's north shore is The Baths, a geological wonder comprised of awe-inspiring granite boulders, which form sheltered sea pools on the beach's edge. Onshore facilities include bathrooms and lockers, creating a safe and enjoyable experience in this unique environment. Visitor entry fees are \$2 for children, \$3 for adults.

SAVANNAH BAY

Savannah Bay features more than a mile of white sand. Except for the beaches of Anegada, no other shore provides such opportunities for long, solitary walks. Sunsets here can be fabulous. The water is calm and typically there are very few people about. There are no facilities and not much shade, so come prepared.

SPRING BAY

To the east of The Baths is Spring Bay. The giant boulders line the beach and there are excellent swimming and snorkeling opportunities for novices and professionals alike. Marine life is vibrant at Spring Bay since fishing is not permitted. A unique enclosure of boulders forms a natural pool called "The Crawl". Its small coves, which provide safe snorkeling, are popular with charter boat guests who moor their boats in the area. The well-manicured lawn leading to the beach is also a favourite for picnic and recreational games. The National Parks Trust has recently put in swings and added picnic benches to further enhance the park.

DEVIL'S BAY

A 15-minute hike from the Top of the Baths brings you to the picturesque Devil's Bay, at Virgin Gorda's south-western tip. Its beaches are a tranquil location for swimming and snorkeling. At the southern end of the beach is a trail to Stoney Bay, where the Atlantic swells pummel the coastline and seabirds soar overhead. Swim line markers guide dinghies safely through the channel and into the bay, where a dinghy dock waits for easy access to the beach. Vessels can use mooring buoys conveniently located outside the bay, preventing anchor damage to the fragile coral heads.

COPPERMINE POINT

Voted "Best Historical Hotspot", This abandoned copper mine played an important role in the history of Virgin Gorda. Spaniards passing through the BVI were the first Europeans to mine coppers here in the early 18th century. Cornish miners built the ruins that remain today in the 1800s. The mine closed in 1862 due to escalating expenses and low market prices. Mine Hill is also a habitat for the White-tailed Tropicbirds that nest in the rocky cliff crevices by the sea.

MOKE RENTALS

It is the Caribbean vacationers' transportation of choice and was introduced on Virgin Gorda in the 1960's. The Mini Mokes became an iconic symbol for the rich and elite, their lavish yet luxurious lifestyles on Virgin Gorda.

HIKING AT GORDA PEAK

The highest point on Virgin Gorda at 1,370ft; Gorda Peak is located on the northwestern ridge, south of North Sound and north of Soldier Bay. Donated by Laurance Rockefeller in 1974, Gorda Peak is one of the last remaining examples of Caribbean dry forest in the region, which makes it a high priority for conservation internationally.
